

Investigation #2: **Prefix, Root, and Suffix Whiteboard Game**

Materials:

- Whiteboard
- List of prefixes, roots, and suffixes with their definition for each student.
 - This list can be the same as Investigation #1 or a shorter one that you have chosen.

Procedure:

- Divide class into 3-4 groups
- Select one student as “host”
- Have groups sit close together.
- Give students their own set of words.
- Ask the students to spread their cards out on their desk, **word side up**.
- Host reads the definition of one of the words.
 - Students all race to pick up the word that matches the definition from their desks and lift it up into the air to signify they have the correct word.
 - Group members may help each other if needed.
- When all groups have all their members raise their card, the host reads the correct answer.
- The first group where all of its members have the correct word wins a point.
 - If a member of the group raises the wrong word, they do not get a point. All members must have the correct word.
- Game continues until all words are used, games time limit is reached or time prohibits further competition.
